Research presentations	Presentations on innovation	Presentations on experiences and best practices
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Research presentations

Presentation of results of partial, final, unpublished, and original research related to any of the thematic lines of the program.

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Educational innovation presentations

Reports on educational innovation experiences through the description of a situation in which a solution was integrated through novelty, as well as the results obtained and the findings of the initiative.

Presentations of experiences and best practices

A presentation that integrates a set of actions that have produced positive or excellent results in a particular setting and these actions are expected to be equally successful in comparable settings.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Fill out the proposal form with the following information (it can be submitted in English or Spanish):
 - Title of the presentation
 - Executive summary: 200 words maximum.
 - Full name of the exhibitor(s), it must include email and resume (semblance).
 - Educational institution of the exhibitor(s).
2. Criteria for selection of submitted papers
 - Alignment of the proposal with the thematic lines of the program.
3. The received papers will be evaluated, and the verdict of the selected papers will be communicated through official HUC mail.
4. Once the work is selected, the author(s) will have 20 working days to send the supporting presentation to use in the exhibition.
5. The time assigned for each participation is 45 minutes of presentation and 15 minutes to answer questions from the audience.
